



Red Oak



Red Oak comes from Eastern Canada and the USA. It belongs to the Fagacae family which has around fifty varieties.

The main colour varies from pink to pale reddish-brown.

Red Oak weighs about 790 kg/m 3 when dried. The trees average about 18-21m in height with a diameter of 1m.

Common uses for Red Oak are furniture, flooring and interior joinery.
